RE: Participation in Manufacturer Recycling Program for Household Lamps

Dear INTERESTED PARTY:

I am writing to inform you of a program offered by 28 manufacturers of *household* mercury-added lamps. As required by Maine law, these manufacturers are offering recycling containers, transport, and processing of waste mercury-added lamps from households at no-cost to eligible retail collection points. The National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) is your point of contact for this program on behalf of these manufacturers.

As you may know, the Efficiency Maine Trust is terminating the current lamp recycling program effective January 1, 2011. As the recycling containers currently in use are pre-paid, please use the existing containers until your supply is exhausted. At that point, if you wish to continue to collect compact fluorescent lamps from households you may participate in the manufacturer program.

To participate in this program, a retailer must agree to certain terms and conditions set forth in a participation agreement as well as the terms and conditions of the Program's recycling vendor, Veolia ES, both of which are enclosed. Please read these carefully. Failure to abide by these requirements may subject your organization to certain fees as established in recycling vendor's standard terms and conditions.

A participation form with these terms and conditions is attached along with Veolia's standard terms and conditions. If you wish to participate in this program, please complete the attached form and mail a signed original to:
